

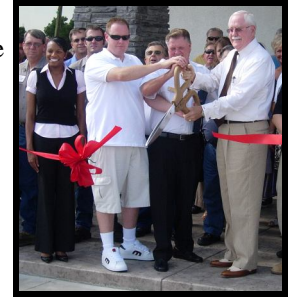

No matter how you measure it, the activities at our new facility during the afternoon and evening of May 28 were *HUGE*.

Our ribbon cutting ceremony, conducted by Bakersfield Mayor Harvey Hall (with acknowledgements by field representatives of Congressman Jim Costa, California State Senator Roy Ashburn, and California Assembly Member Jean Fuller), was witnessed by a near record-breaking crowd of Central California Power employees, vendors, customers, along with Ambassadors and Staff from the Greater Bakersfield Chamber of Commerce.



When the ceremony was completed, tours of the 30,000+ square foot shop, hosted by Rod and Blake Headley, began as hundreds of vehicles were guided onto the acres of paved parking lot to join in the customer appreciation Open House, combined with their hosting of the Chamber of Commerce *Business After Hours Mixer*.

Well over 500 guests mingled through shop, talked with mechanics and technicians stationed by various large scale equipment re-powers, diesel engine repairs, and DPF retrofit projects, and reviewed a mini-trade show with more than 15 vendor booths displaying industrial off-road engines, commercial generators, diesel particulate filters (DPF's), fuel storage tanks, new field service trucks, and electronic control systems, along with many other state-of-the-art components.

While the food (by Luigi's, with desserts by the Sweet Shop) was plentiful and there were enough "libation stations" to keep all visitors hydrated and "liquefied," the evenings' action was only briefly interrupted by the lengthy list of high value door prizes, including I Pods, three large-scale flat screen TV's, and dozens of gift bags with certificates for restaurants, vehicle services, or professional sports tickets.

At the wrap-up, departing guests expressed their amazement about the quality and sheer size of the facility and the event. "My wife mentioned that the Mixer was going to be at a diesel shop, and my first thought was: 'I really didn't want to go'. I had no idea that a shop could look this clean and impressive, or the quantity and scope of the projects *that help clean our air* going on here," exclaimed one influential Chamber member.

### Are You Ready?

If you or your company recently received the third and final official letter from the ARB regarding your older diesel equipment on PERP permits, you know that there is no extension or renewals.

We have studied many lists, and have noticed that some permits may have already expired, with the last of the permits to expire on 12/31/09.

To avoid penalties and fines, PERP equipment must be permanently re-powered with TIER compliant engines, replaced, retired, or scrapped.

Since replacement is subject to the compliance verification/inspection process by the AQMD, which can currently take as long as 90 days. We anticipate that the process will take longer as the deadlines get closer.

### Investment in Data Loggers = *service now available*

“Our acquisition of a quantity of data loggers means that Central California Power is already serving our customers’ needs to gather the necessary baseline data for the various government funding programs for mandated DPF installations on off-road equipment,” mentions Laurie, Emissions Solutions Team member. “In order to go to the next step for DPF installation, temporary attachment of data logging equipment is required. We are updating our schedule for data logger availability. I suggest that you call now to learn when the next dates are open.”
